Students who apply should be in good academic standing and provide the following:

- 1. A completed application form.
- 2. An essay on why they feel they should be considered and how the scholarship would further promote their music education.
 - 3. A recommendation from their high school music teacher or private instructor.
 - 4. A recommendation from their high school teacher of choice.

SUBMITTAL DATE- MARCH 1

Applications are due, postmarked no later than March 1.

Announcement of the recipient will be no later than March 15.

Applicants understand that their scholarship award expects them to perform with the chorus at Snug Harbor Chorus concerts in the Spring and in December. That if a senior is selected for this scholarship we understand if they can't perform at Holiday concert in December. Scholarship recipients will meet with the SHCC Music Director to assess awardee skills to determine how these might be showcased in the SHCC concerts.

Recipients will be expected to attend 1-2 rehearsals during the weeks prior to concert.
